Founders Circle Levels:

Peter Noyes Supporter - \$100 (1589-1656) A Founding Father of Sudbury and a Representative of the General Court

General membership benefits, plus Noyes Supporters are invited to special events each year, which often includes at least one visit to a private site of historical or architectural significance.

General John Nixon Champion - \$150 (1724-1815) A Revolutionary War General General membership benefits, plus Nixon Champions and their families are invited to special events each year.
